Marcia Ann "Honey" Bye July 27, 1954 ~ October 17, 2011 Marcia passed away on October 17, 2011, after a prolonged illness as a result of diabetes. She was born on July 27, 1954 in Vancouver, WA and adopted by Tony and Marge DeGrande three days later. Marcia grew up in Washougal, WA, attending elementary school and graduating from Washougal High School in 1972. She then went to work for her dad, the owner of Washougal Electric. Later she attended the Clark College Culinary Arts Program receiving an Associate Degree. In 1985 she was reacquainted with Fred Bye whom she had met in the late 1970's when she picked up heating and air conditioning equipment for her dad. Fred had recently started employment with Johnstone Supply, an HVAC/R Distributor. They were married Sept. 10, 1988. After her dad retired, Marcia worked as a claims processor for a third party health administrator and then for Keelson Partners Insurance Agency. She ran their Christmas Tree liability program for tree lots and u-cut farms for 13 years. Her favorite time of year was Christmas. For 22 years the Bye's put on a Holiday Party for their friends and relatives. Marcia was a gifted crafter, which included wedding photography, sewing, knitting, and tole and decorative painting. She and her sister Lori would hold painting workshops for their friends. In the last several years they were avidly involved in cake decorating. Marcia's husband Fred; sister Lori DeGrande; best friend Steve Gregory; mother Marge Mickelson; step-sisters Karen and Lynette Mickelson; close friends Dean and Kate Teehee, Audrey Borwieck, Jennifer Rilatos; nieces Nicole, Ashley, and

Tristen; five great-nephews; and Boomer her dog, survive her.
