



## Marguerite Joyce Brady-Ciampa

November 29, 1934 - July 14, 2023

Marguerite Brady-Ciampa, of Vancouver, Washington, was born on November 29, 1934, in Fruita, Colorado, to Barnell Brady and Abbie Boyd Brady. She was raised and received her primary education at Campion Academy in Colorado and then attended Walla Walla College where she received the Bachelor of Arts degree with a major in Business and a minor in Piano Performance. She was one of the first women admitted to and then attended the University of Washington Law School.

She received a master's degree from Long Island University (NY) and then a Doctorate in Counseling Psychology from The University of Northern Colorado.

She taught in public schools in Long Island, New York, Greeley, Colorado, and served as a Counselor at Woodland High School, Woodland, Washington. She also taught at The University of Northern Colorado and was Associate Professor of Psychology and Chairman of the Psychology Department at Wayne State College, Wayne, Nebraska. In addition, she served as Clinical Director at Valley Hope in Nebraska, and, after moving to Washington, obtained her Serie 7/63 stockbrokers licenses from the SEC/NASD.

She was also a classical music enthusiast, master gardener, supporter of many charities, and the creator of more than 70 quilts.

She is survived by her husband of 42 years, Bart of Vancouver, daughters, Suzanne Hutson of Portland, Oregon, Lisa Young of Pflugerville, Texas, Robyn Cleveland of Romsey, England, sisters Miriam Redfield and Eleanor

Hetke, both of Vancouver, and six grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents and by her sons, Gregory Scott and Garrett Todd.
