Marie Viola Bradbury, 100, went home to be with her Lord on April 14, 2020, of natural causes at Sequoia Heights Adult Living Home.

Marie was born on February 18, 1920, in Pullman, WA, to Fred and Anna Connick. She was raised on their family farm northeast of Genesee, ID.

She graduated from Genesee High School and in 1943 earned a bachelor's degree in Home Economics from the University of Idaho. Marie taught Home Economics and business courses in Lewiston, ID and later in Challis, ID. After Lawrence Bradbury of Challis, ID was honorably discharged from the military having served in World War II, he returned to his college sweetheart.

Lawrence and Marie were married on November 18, 1945, at Saint John's Lutheran Church in Genesee, ID. They made their home in Challis, ID, raising cattle on the family ranch. Marie worked at the Custer County Bank until their children were born. Then she devoted her attention to being a homemaker. Through the years, she enjoyed cooking, sewing, knitting, arranging flowers, gardening, bridge, traveling, and was an active member of different churches wherever they lived. In 1981, they moved from Challis, ID to Lewiston, ID; in 2000, from Lewiston to Klamath Falls, OR; and in 2016, from Klamath Falls to Brush Prairie, WA
