Born in Bull Run, OR, she lived throughout the west, including Arizona, California and Oregon before settling down with her husband and young family in North Bonneville, WA. Mrs. Knight was a dedicated homemaker, raising three boys, while pursuing her lifelong interests in painting and local history. Many of her paintings were ribbon winners in the Skamania County Fair. Her diligent pursuit of documenting local history was valued by the Skamania County Historical Society, of which she was a long time member. Marie was also an active member of the Cape Horn Grange along with her late husband, Parker L. Knight, and served in a variety of roles, including Grange Master in the mid-80's. Survivors include her sons, Roger of Portland, OR (wife Tonya), Richard of The Dalles, OR (wife Diane), and Ronald of Camas (wife Karen); as well as her brothers, Ron, Jack, and Robert; sister, Verla; six great-grand children; and a multitude of great-great-grandchildren.
