Marjorie was born to Summer and Minnie Collins on July 10, 1926 in Omaha, Nebraska.

She graduated from Omaha Benson High School in 1944, and attended a year of college at the then Omaha University. She Retired from NW Bell Telephone Co. in 1977 after over 31 years of service.

Marjorie was a 50-year member of the Order of the Eastern Star, Narcissus Chapter #269. She was also a lifetime member of the Telephone Pioneers of America; the Humane Society of the United States; the American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals; the AARP, and the AAA.

Marjorie previously volunteered several years for the American Red Cross at their blood drives. In her earlier years she was a 5-gallon blood donor to the Red Cross.

Since 1992 she had volunteered each week at the PeaceHealth S.W. Washington Medical Center in Vancouver, having accrued over 14,000 hours of service. She was the recipient of both the "Presidential Volunteer Service" award and the "Presidential Call to Service" award.

On February 14, 1987, Marjorie was married to Max E. Crawford; however, their happy marriage was short-lived as Max passed away on October 22, 1988.

Marjorie is survived by her nephews and nieces: Gregory Collins (Penny); Steve Collins; Connie Collins; and many grand and great-grand nieces and

nephews. She was preceded in death by her parents, two brothers, and their wives: Donald S. Collins and Agnes; Ralph W. Collins and Joyce.
