She attended Roosevelt High School in Portland, OR, where she was the first woman to earn a letterman's jacket for athletics at Roosevelt High School. After high school she became a welder and riveter as her contribution to the war effort. She married Edward A. Prentice (d.2004), November 15, 1947. They were married 57 years. In 1955 they moved to Vancouver, WA to the home they built, and there they raised seven children. Marjorie had a number of interests, her favorites were art and golf. She had a special interest in portrait painting. She was a member of Royal Oak Golf Club for many years. She is survived by her children Bob (Carolyn) Prentice, Mary Ellen (John) Sullivan, Paul Prentice, Jean (David) Bomar, Marjorie A. (Philip) Rolwes, Edward C. (Roni) Prentice, and Catherine (Mike) James. She is also survived by 40 grandchildren, 42 great-grandchildren, and five great-great-grandchildren.
