Rogen passed away peacefully in his sleep on June 21, 2018, at the age of 66, after a long and courageous battle with Frontotemporal dementia (Alzheimer's Disease). He served as a Deputy Sheriff and later a Sergeant for the Skamania County Sheriff's Office for 31 years, including eight years working as a police officer for the City of North Bonneville. Upon his retirement, he spent one year as the Police Chief of North Bonneville, before retiring from law enforcement and moving to Vancouver, WA. Mark is survived by his children, Mark Jr. (Victoria) and Meredith Rogen of Vancouver, WA; his adopted children, Lora Shinn of Seattle, WA, Andrew (Steffanie) Sampeck of Sutter, CA, and Emily Sampeck-Rogen of Portland, OR; grandchildren, Wyatt and Levi Rogen of Vancouver, WA, Isabelle and Emmitt Shinn of Seattle, WA, and Hannah Sampeck of Sutter, CA; his siblings, Dawn (Rogen) Bainter and James Rogen of Vancouver, WA.
