



## Marolyn Lyle Heuer

December 22, 1933 - March 15, 2010

Marolyn Heuer, 76, of Vancouver, WA, passed away on March 15, 2010 at her home. She was born Dec. 22, 1933 followed by her twin sister Carolyn seven minutes later on Dec. 23 in Tacoma, WA. Marolyn at five years old moved to Mercer Island and lived at Children's Educational Foundation Boarding School with her twin sister, Carolyn and older sister, Betty. In 1942 she moved to Longmire, Mt. Rainier National Park Headquarters, where her mother remarried and Tom, her brother, was born in Aug. of 1944. Marolyn attended Eatonville High School and graduated in 1951. Shortly after high school she moved to Tacoma and worked for an insurance company for several years. In June of 1953 she wed her husband Ed to whom she was married for 41 years. Marolyn and Ed moved to Leonard, North Dakota in 1955 where they worked the family wheat and dairy farm for 10 years. In 1965 they moved back to Tacoma, WA where Ed worked at Boeing for a couple of years before they settled in Vancouver. Her husband Ed died in 1994. Shortly after their move to Vancouver Marolyn again began working in insurance. Later Marolyn eventually opened Heuer Insurance a Grange office. She worked and volunteered tirelessly for Grange Insurance where she served as Secretary, Treasurer, and was a state delegate. In 2000 Marolyn retired. Marolyn loved to sew, making many things for kids and grandkids. She also loved to cook meals from scratch for her family during holidays. She also enjoyed bowling, bingo, butterflies, and collectable's. Marolyn is survived by her four children, Kathy Viers (David), Karen Heuer, Joel Heuer, Valerie Pool (Rob); 12

grandchildren; and several great-grandchildren.
