Mary Frangos, nee Miller, 93, passed away Jan. 30, 2024, in Vancouver, WA, where she had lived for the past five and a half years at Springwood Landing. She was born in 1930 in Springfield, MA (and was a lifelong Boston Red Sox fan). Mary was preceded in death by her beloved husband, George. She is survived by son, Scott Frangos (and fiancé Patricia Jenson who assisted in care for Mary); niece, Deborah Hilfiker; and nephew, William Pellatt, both of Florida.

She is remembered for her great love of the family dogs and in particular their last dog, Kona, so named in honor of a number of annual trips to Kona, HI, with husband, George.
