Maurice "Morry" Allen Stamp, 86, passed away on March 18, 2016 in Vancouver, WA. He was born on Aug. 28, 1929 in Hendricks, MN but grew up in South Dakota on the family farm with three siblings. Morry served in the Army from 1951 to 1953 in a tank battalion in German. He married Dorothy Simmonson in February 1959. In 1963, the family moved to Vancouver, WA. Morry started working as a mechanic in 1964 for the county, where he retired in 1990, after 26 years of service. Morry enjoyed the outdoors and time with family. He loved to "play" in the yard with whatever equipment he had available. After retirement, Morry found a new hobby restoring old tractors.
