Michael Augustus Pitts was born October 19, 1928 to Richard and Marie (Hull) Pitts in Vancouver, Washington, and died, just shy of his 85th birthday, on October 9, 2013. He lived most of his life in Clark County, and spent a couple of retirement years in Ocean Park, Washington, before returning home to Vancouver and Battle Ground, WA. In Germany, during the War of Occupation, Mike was in the Army and served as a Master Cook in the officer's lounge, and had a variety of jobs after returning home, until becoming a carpenter for 38 years with Local 1715. He was an avid hunter and fisherman, and especially loved clam digging and spending time with his family.
