Sis faced the diagnosis of cancer in 2000 with courage and optimism, as she had with every challenge. Faith in God and enduring the successful treatments kept it in remission for ten years, allowing her to see three great-granddaughters come into the world and welcome a Step-great-grandson into the family. Sis had a gentle loving spirit that will be missed in this world. Her gift of hospitality was much appreciated. Never could you just "drop by"

without receiving something to eat or drink, and her lemon cake at the July Fourth picnic was always something to look forward to, as was her warm smile and laughter.
