Nancy Louise Bommer left us the evening of March 27, 2024, in her Vancouver home, surrounded by loved ones, after an 11 year battle with ovarian cancer. She lived 76 beautiful years. Never taking a single one for granted. She was a woman who wholeheartedly loved life and those around her. One look at her and he was smitten. Despite her best efforts to hide from their first date, they quickly fell in love, and married June 27, 1986. Nancy and Allen built a wonderful life together, bringing out the best in each other everyday. Their home would be the set for so many cherished memories with family and friends. Whether

someone needed a hand, an ear, or just a glass of wine, the Bomers' was the place to go. In their retirement in 1996, Allen and Nancy traveled by automobile, plane and motorhome to visit their favorite places, with all of their favorite people.
