PAULINE A. KIMMELSHUE 1927 2010 Pauline was born October 14, 1927 in Waverly, Iowa to William E. & Laura Kimmelshue. Pauline had four siblings Marian, James, twin-brother Paul and John. Following the death of her mother, Laura Kimmelshue in January of 1938, the family headed west, arriving in the Vancouver, Washington area on Halloween eve in 1941. After graduating from high school, Pauline attended Bible School in Three Hills, Canada. Upon completion of her courses at Bible School Pauline returned to the US, where she worked as a nurse in Kellogg and Wallace, Idaho. In 1959 Pauline returned to the Vancouver, Washington area where she obtained a position with the Army Engineers Department in Portland, Oregon. In 1960, shortly after beginning work for the government a position opened up for an editor in Seoul, Korea. Pauline took this opportunity and spent the next 15 years working and living in Korea. Pauline later had the opportunity to work in Saudi Arabia where she lived and worked for 4 years. Pauline returned to the US and took a position in Jackson, Mississippi, until her retirement in the 1980's. After her time in Jackson, Mississippi, she lived a short time in Raleigh, North Carolina, finally returning to the Vancouver area where she had lived for the last 21 years. She is survived by her brother John Kimmelshue of Hood River, Oregon.
