Priscilla Jean Huitt, age 74, passed away Thursday, June 3rd 2021 at Community Home Health and Hospice in Longview, WA. During her years, Prissy enjoyed Volkswalking with a number of friends, volunteering time with Christian Deaf Fellowship, volunteering her time at retreats for Deaf-Blind folks. She helped as a bookkeeper at her church, participating in many church activities. Above all, Prissy enjoyed water aerobics with Patty and other friends at the YMCA swimming pool in Longview. After the exercise, Prissy and Patty often stopped in at Starbucks for a tasty beverage!
