On Thurs., June 4, 2020, Richard "Rick" John Mason, 56, passed away at his home in Vancouver, Washington.

He was born to parents Richard Charles and Janice Ann Mason on Offutt Air Force Base just outside Omaha, Nebraska. He spent most of his childhood in Riverside, California before his family relocated to Vancouver, Washington where he graduated from Evergreen High School in 1982.

A few years after high school, Rick would move to Lake Tahoe where he would work as a slot machine technician at Harrah's.
