Richard Charles Schwab; just shy of his 89th birthday, was born at home in Corvallis, Montana on September 18, 1922. Richard aspired to leadership early in life as editor of his high school newspaper and was Student Body President of Whitworth College in Spokane. He graduated in 1945 with a degree in Chemistry and began a promising career, but God had a different plan for his life. He went to Dallas Theological Seminary to prepare for vocational ministry. Pastoring just three churches in over 45 years of ministry; Burke Avenue Chapel in Seattle, Progress Bible Church in Tigard, now Southwest Bible, and Minnehaha Community Church in Vancouver, now Glenwood. He was a shepherd to his flock and loved God's people. To God be the glory. He is survived by his five children, Ann Boyett, Tim Schwab, Mary Beaumont, Ron Schwab and Norm Schwab; 15 grandkids; and two great-grandchildren. A memorial service will be held at Glenwood Community Church at 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 11th.
