ROBERT KIMBALL CASSIDY July 13, 1914 ~ May 31, 2015 100 year old Vancouver resident Robert Kimball Cassidy passed away on Sunday, May 31, 2015 at Brookdale Senior Living. Robert was born in Grand Forks, ND on July 13, 1914 to Elsie Jane Anderson Cassidy and Frank Warner Cassidy. After many transitional moves, the family settled in Vancouver. On May 4, 1936, Bob married Valeda (Lynne) Carol Jennison. Together they welcomed three sons. Bob and Lynne were married for 44 years until she passed away in 1980. As a young father in the early days of WWII Bob worked at the Kaiser shipyards in Vancouver. Following the war, in 1949, he used his skills and innovative mind to start his business, Cassidy Manufacturing. Upon his retirement he married Catherine (Kay) Ann Roberts McAlvey on June 1, 1983. They enjoyed 20 years together, traveling and living in Palm Springs. Kay passed away in 2003. Bob was an active member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (LDS). Over the years he served in many positions in Vancouver and Palm Springs. He was active in civic and charitable organizations and gave freely of his time and talents. Bob is survived by his sons, David (Marilyn) of Provo, UT, Bruce of Camas, WA, Craig (Laurie) of Vancouver, WA and the McAlvey stepchildren, Michael, Tom and Cathy Crandal. A stepson, Kevin, preceded Bob in death.
