



## Robert James Snyder

October 20, 1937 - November 24, 2010

Robert "Bob" J. Snyder of Vancouver, WA, passed away on Nov. 24, 2010. He was the son of George W. Snyder and Ethel Snyder. Bob worked on the family turkey farm east of Orchards while growing up and graduated from Evergreen High School in 1955. During his college years, Bob was enlisted with the National Guard of Washington and was involved in radio broadcasting and acting at Clark College and WSU, receiving a Bachelor of Arts degree in Speech from WSU. Bob married Susan Dietz on August 29th, 1964 and they had two children together. He received his real estate license in 1964 and opened "Bob Snyder Real Estate" in Vancouver, WA shortly thereafter. Bob served as past President of the Clark County Board of Realtors and was member of the Million Dollar Realty Club and was named Realtor of the Year in 1972. Bob operated his real estate business as broker until the mid-1990's. He closed his office and sold his building in downtown Vancouver, taking early retirement due to the effects of Parkinson's. In his spare time, Bob enjoyed flying his Piper PA-28 Cherokee airplane, playing his guitar, vacationing in Hawaii, going on cruises with friends and family, playing in realtor softball tournaments and classic cars. Bob is survived by his brother, Richard Snyder; two children, Brett Snyder and Bobby Snyder; three grandchildren, Amanda, Ashton and Alivia; and a niece and nephew, Sherry Raz and Mark Snyder. He was preceded in death by his mother, father and wife.
