Ronald Hendricks born to Rolland and Goldie Hendricks May 4, 1935 in Fort Madison, IA. He was preceded in death by his wife of 42 years, Ruby; and his son, Ron Beebe. He is survived by his daughters, Jan Nutter (AC), Patty Fjeldos (Warren); daughter-in-law, Karl Bebee; seven grandchildren and 19 great-grandchildren.

Ron proudly served his country by joining the Navy and going off to the Korean war on the USS William Serverling. He left his senior year behind at Wenatchee High School. Years later a program was offered to anyone that had left high school to be in the armed forces to get their diploma if they completed the course of study. He completed his course and graduated in 2010 at the age of 72.

He retired from Smurfit Paper Mill in Oregon City. Afterwards Ron and Ruby moved from Vancouver to the Long Beach area where their new home was. There they enjoyed fishing, clam digging and crabbing. They also made many trips to Montana and Wyoming for big game hunting. They traveled south for a few winters down around Arizona. After Ruby passed, years later he sold his beach home and moved to Powell Butte with his companion Barbara Burdick and bought his home in Lapine, OR.

An aggressive cancer of the bladder did not respond to treatment and he

passed quietly and pain free on Dec. 29, 2021.

Ron's service will be held at Evergreen Memorial Gardens on Thursday, March 10, at 12:30 p.m.
