



Samuel Turkle Beall

March 24, 1919 - March 27, 2010

Dr. Samuel T. Beall, 91, of Vancouver, WA, passed away on March 27, 2010. He was born in Pt. Marion, PA to Clarence and Eula Beall and moved to Boise, ID as a young child. Samuel graduated from Whitman College in 1940 and from the University of Louisville Medical School in 1950. He served in the Army Air Corp in the South Pacific during World War II. Dr. Beall was a physician with the Vancouver Clinic for 35 years and he retired in 1989. He served as an associate clinical professor at Oregon Health Sciences University. He was a past president of the Clark County Physicians Services, Clark County Medical Society and the Vancouver Rotary Club. Other community activities included United Way, Health and Welfare Planning Council of Clark County and St. Luke's Episcopal Church. Dr. Beall was named First Citizen in 1990 and was instrumental in starting the Free Clinic of Southwest Washington. He enjoyed several hobbies: gardening, woodworking, and reading. Dr. Beall is survived by his wife of 63 years, Marjorie; children, Fred, Cheryl Ford, Bruce, Gretchen Miller and spouses; nine grandchildren; and two great-grandchildren. A memorial service to honor Dr. Beall will be held on Sat., April 10, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. at St. Luke's Episcopal Church.
