Sharlie Long was born November 29th, 1940 in Great Falls, Montana. She changed her line of work, and early on she worked retail in several stores and in the credit office for Montgomery Ward.

During 1963 she married, Dean Smith and had four children; Karen Ann, Mary Emma, Raymond Dean, and Michael Emmett.

Sharlie worked as a mother, a homemaker, a school bus driver, a paper route supervisor, sold Celebrity Jewelry and Hostess House Interior Décor, delivered lost luggage for the airlines, and doing floral delivery in the Portland / Vancouver area.

During 1981 she married, Rudy Prosser. He preceded her in death, June 1993.

Sharlie loved to read, laugh, flowers, have everything clean, crime investigation shows, cats, king-sized Hershey bars with almonds, giraffes, family history research, and her family. A sign hung above the kitchen table states "How we spend our days is how we spend our lives."

Survivors include her brother Raymond; daughters, Karen and Mary; sons, Raymond and Michael; six grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren.
