



## Terrance D. Hannan

August 26, 1944 - April 28, 2025

Terrance D. Hannan (Terry), 80, of Vancouver, WA, passed away peacefully on April 28, 2025.

Born in Aberdeen, WA, and raised in Raymond, WA, Terry was the son of the late Robert A.

Hannan and Marie C. Hannan.

Terry graduated from Raymond High School in 1963 before attending Washington State

University and the University of Oregon Law School. After law school, Terry moved to

Vancouver, WA, where he began a career at what would become the law firm of Reed, Wolfe,

Hannan, and Mercer. He excelled at the intellectual side of the legal profession.

In addition to his legal career, he was for many decades an active member of the Memorial

Lutheran Church in Vancouver, where he frequently taught Sunday school.

His faith and

dedication to his church were an essential part of his life.

Terry had a quick, wry sense of humor. He was also an avid lover of astronomy (attending many

star parties in particular), action movies (the more explosions, the better), and sci-fi novels (he

had many, many paperback sci fi novels scattered about his residence). He also loved to travel, taking many cruises in particular.

He is survived by his twin brother Tim Hannan (who is one minute older), a sister-in-law, Linden Renner of Oakton, VA, and two nieces: Lindsay Hannan of Atlanta, GA, and Kerry Hannan of Brooklyn, NY.

In his final years, Terry resided at Glenwood Place Senior Living and Memory Care in

Vancouver, where he was lovingly cared for.

Interment is planned at Evergreen Memorial Gardens. His ashes will reside next to those of his parents.
