



Thor R. Hanson, Sr.

February 3, 1925 - August 27, 2009

Thor R. Hanson passed away quietly in his home in Vancouver, WA on August, 27, 2009. He was 84 years old. Thor Roland Hanson, Sr. was born in Svartbyn, Overkalix, Sweden. He came to the U.S. when he was 3 years old. Thor graduated from Crystal Lake High School in Crystal Lake, IL. He enlisted in the Air Force in 1943 and served until 1965 when he retired. Thor flew 24 bombing missions over the Channel into France & Germany during WWII. He received many accommodations & metals for his military service. After military retirement, Thor worked for Boeing Air Craft until he retired in 1987. Thor moved with his wife of 58 years, Kathryn Hanson from Tacoma, WA to Vancouver WA in the early 1990s. He is survived by his wife Kathryn D. Hanson, sons John P Hanson (wife-Ellen) of Battle Ground, WA, David L Hanson (wife-Susanne) of Vancouver, WA, Grandson, Matthew Bate (US Army - Afghanistan)stepsons, Ronald Holmes (Mobile AL), and Donald Holmes(Mobile AL) one great-grand child, five step-grand children and three stepgreat-grand children He is proceeded in death by two sons, Richard A. Hanson and Thor R. Hanson Jr (wife: Donna (living) and one step daughter, Frances Holmes. Thor was a dedicated husband and father and he will be missed by all.
