William "Bill" Charles Mauck, age 97, passed away at the Vancouver VA CLC with family at his side on Wednesday, September 25, 2024. He was born on August 17, 1927 in Estherville, Iowa to Clarence and Lillian (Eisenhower) Mauck. He attended school in Estherville and graduated from Estherville High school in 1945. Bill served in the Navy and was stationed in the Philippines. On November 14, 1948 he married Florence Zaugg, and they had two children, Joni and Donn. Over the course of his life, he had several occupations including owning a cafe, working for Alcoa and then as a financial planner for IDS. Bill and Florence enjoyed traveling and had the opportunity to visit many foreign countries including Scotland where he was able to golf at St Andrews golf course. After retirement he was busy volunteering for the Humane Society, the Grandparent program, was a Long term Care Ombudsman and gave blood (platelets) regularly. Bill's favorite pastimes included golf, bridge and watching football and golf on TV. He played golf this past August with his grandsons and a great grandson. Sobriety was a very important part of Bill's life, and he was known to have helped many people over the course of his sobriety. Bill is survived by his daughter Joni Schneider (Louis), son Donn Mauck, six grandchildren Les Schneider, Doug Schneider, Tracey Doss (Cory), Julia Sowieja (Joel) Rob Schneider (Allison), Mallory Hamilton (Cody) and thirteen great grandchildren and his canine companion Sophie.
